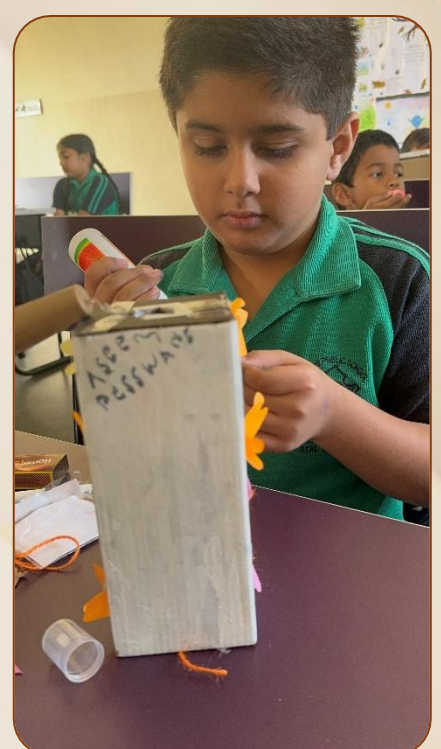
Illuminating Minds: Celebrating the Festival of Lights

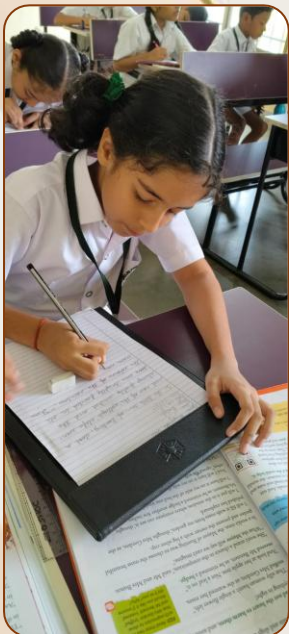
"Joyful Noel: A Celebration of Love and Artistry"

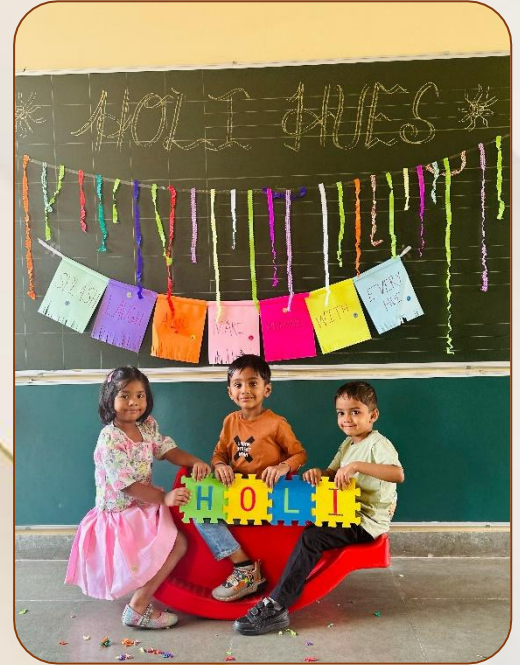
Scribbling Excellence: English & Hindi Handwriting

Growing Together: A Tapestry of Culture

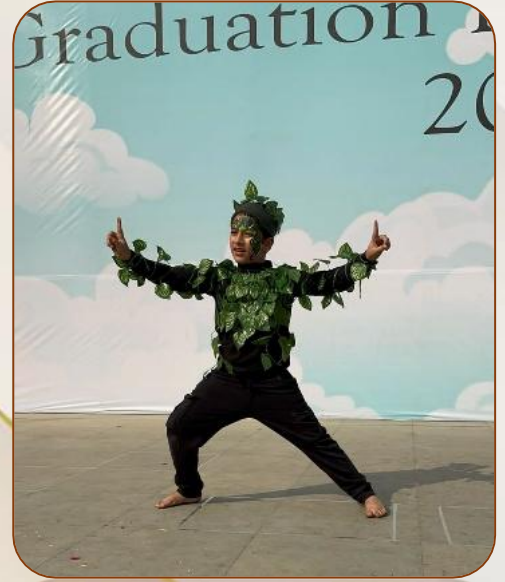

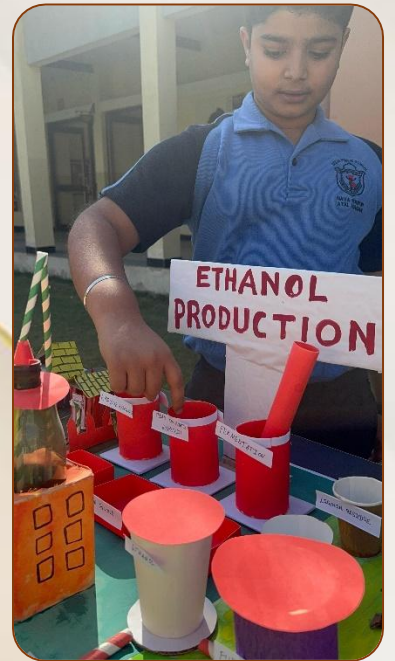


Spontaneous Brilliance
