Show and Tell

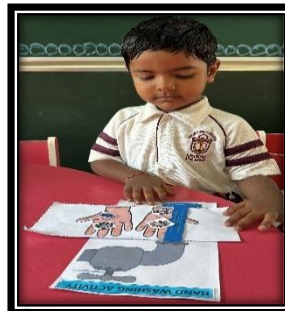

Pleasant Practices

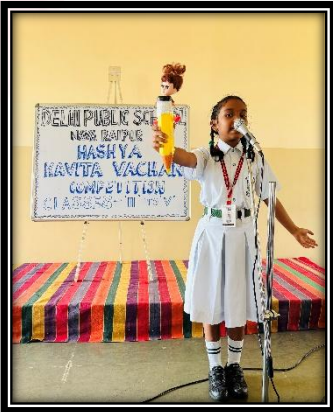

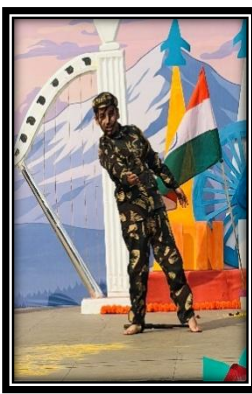
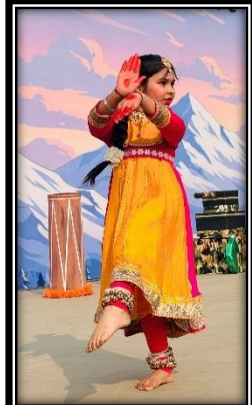
Handwriting Harmony

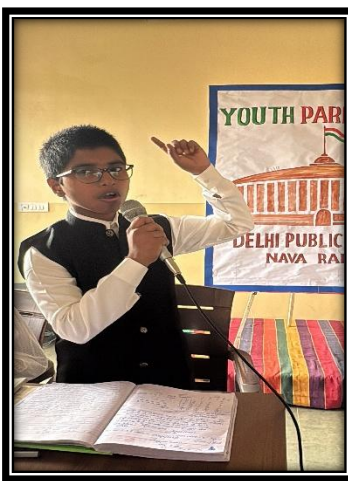


Youth Parliament: A Voice of Democracy in Action

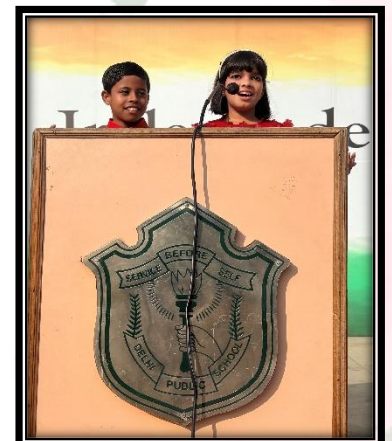

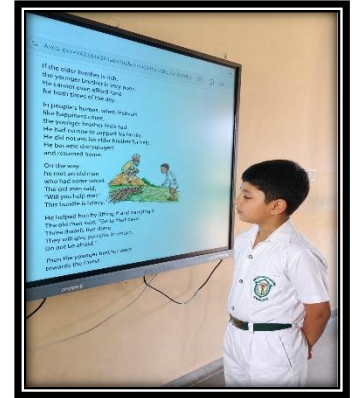
to the needy—proving that small efforts can create a big impact.



Reading Challenge: A Celebration of Words

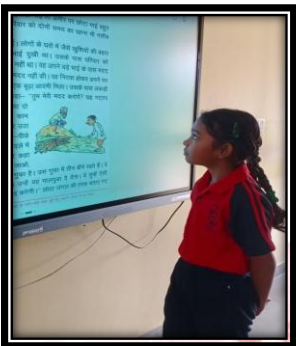

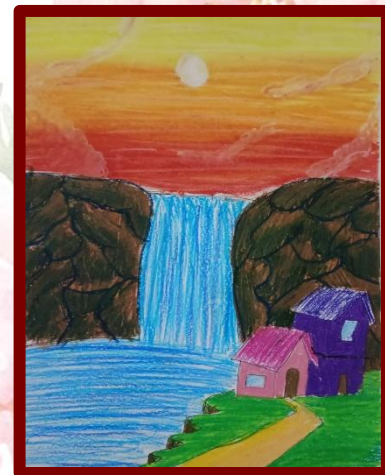

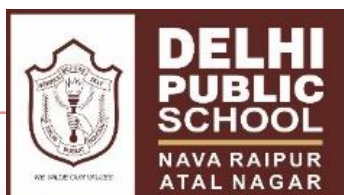
